- ◆ **Christmas Baskets:** Each year our community fills approximately 60 Christmas baskets for families in need.
- ◆ **St. Vincent de Paul Society:** Our parish has a SVDP Conference that annually provides emergency assistance. The volunteers help meet and take emergency assistance call from needy families.
- ◆ **Little Flower:** St Pius partners with local food banks in the area.
- ◆ **Aurora Warm the Night:** Help the homeless during the winter time and serve cold beverages and lunches during the hottest month.
- ◆ **Gabriel House:** St. Pius' Pro Life group has partnered with Gabriel House. Gabriel House is an outreach program of the Archdiocese of Denver committed to helping pregnant women and women with young children in need of resources.

Catechetical Ministries

- ◆ **Children's Church:** At 9:00 a.m. on Sundays, the children, age 3-5, are led in worship through song, story, and prayer.
- ◆ **RCIA** is a program for those adults interested in becoming Catholics or who like to make any of their Sacraments.
- ◆ **Religious Education:**
 - ⇒First Communion Classes 2nd—5th grade (2 year Program).
 - ⇒Confirmation Classes 8th- 12th grade (2 year Program).
 - ⇒ First Communion Classes 6th —12th grade. Older children that need to make their first communion also need to register for the program.



◆ **English Baptism:**

- ⇒Must complete the packet at least one month before the baptism date.
- ⇒The Baptism Class is offered the 1st Saturday of each month at 3:30 pm in the Family Life Center. (Please arrive on time).
- ⇒The Baptisms are the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:00 AM. (Must Register).

- ◆ **Mass Intentions:** One intention is offered per each mass. Please call the main office to check availability.

Marriage Preparation

- ◆ Preparation for engaged couples begins with a visit to the pastor 9 months prior to the wedding date.
- ◆ Call parish to schedule an appointment with the priest.
- ◆ Meet with priest.
- ◆ Couple must take the FOCCUS Test.
- ◆ Be enrolled in the wedding preparation classes.
- ◆ Baptism and Confirmation Certificates are needed.

SOCIAL ACTIONS

- ◆ **After School Meals & Snacks for Delores House and CNN:** These programs provide meals for the Delores House Battered and Homeless Women's Shelter and snacks for the street kids enrolled in the Colfax Community Network. Volunteers cook various dishes, several times a month.
- ◆ **Soup Kitchen:** St. Pius volunteers are responsible for serving the meal at the St. Francis Soup Kitchen once a month, on the 2ND Friday. Volunteers gather at the rectory at 2 p.m. Return to St. Pius at 5:30 p.m.
- ◆ **Food Bank of the Rockies:** A group of our volunteers go on Wednesdays and Fridays to help repackage food for local non-profit charities.
